Grandstand® is a post emergence herbicide for use on managed amenity turf for the control of a wide range of broad-leaved weeds, including daisy, dandelion, clover, buttercup and plantain.

Following crops	After an application of Grandstand [®] there are no restrictions for sowing any succeeding crop after application. However, for sensitive species such as clover or sunflower ploughing is recommended prior to drilling.

Rainfastness	Grandstand is rainfast one hour after application
Buffer Zone:	5m reducible buffer zone (1m dry ditches)

How to get the best from Grandstand®

- Grandstand[®] can be applied to established managed amenity turf including lawns. Newly sown turf needs to become
 established before treating.
- Apply to small and actively growing weeds.
- Avoid moving 3 days before and 7 days after application to ensure sufficient weed leaf surface for application and translocation into the roots.
- Do not apply if the turf is wet.
- Do not apply if the turf is under stress, especially from variable temperatures, drought or cold, dry weather.
- Grass clippings must be composted for a minimum of 4 months before being used as a mulch.
- The use of low drift nozzles is recommended and don't spray on a windy day.
- Don't spray when temperatures are more than 25°C in the shade.
- Do not apply with hand-held equipment.
- To avoid subsequent injury to sensitive crops, spray equipment used for Grandstand applications should be thoroughly cleaned with All Clear Extra or a similar proprietary tank cleaner.

Turf Safety

Grandstand® has been found to be safe on the following range of grass species:

Timothy	Fescue spp.
Annual meadow-grass	Perennial & Italian ryegrass
Cock's foot	Smooth meadow grass
Common bent	Creeping bent
Rescue brome	

However, as there are many different cultivars grown, it may be best to test a small area of turf for safety before overall application.
